MINISTRY STORY

Every day that I was in Ecuador for the Latin ministry residency, I had to walk up four flights of steps to reach the classroom. With the altitude in Quito being 9,350 feet, I would have to stop a few times to catch my breath. Although we had a beautiful view of the city from a wall of windows, I was looking forward to leaving so I could breathe.

One day, after taking student pictures outside, a student asked to speak with me. We sat down in a private place where she shared through tears about her struggles to be respected as a woman in ministry. I listened quietly and then we prayed. Suddenly I heard voices calling for me and I realized I had lost track of time. This was during the pandemic and an employee from a local lab was waiting to draw my blood for a COVID test. To my surprise, I ran and did not even become short of breath.

Afterward, I thought about my own struggles in life and how the Holy Spirit

puts us in the right place to be a blessing. Each experience in ministry is a new adventure, and I have learned that God walks with me and gives me what I need to serve him, yes, even down to the ability to breathe.
