MINISTRY STORY

One of our leaders, "Agatha", was reprimanded some time back for her involvement in a group activity that was not responsible, especially considering her status as a leader other women look up to as an example. She received the correction well and humbly, and she showed signs of remorse.

Not long afterward, she was asked if she wanted to share her testimony at a church invitation. She declined, saying, "I don't feel worthy after what happened"—an indication not only of shame but also integrity. Since then, Agatha has gotten over her initial shame and has grown from the experience. Now she is able to share her personal story, which communicates clearly and powerfully how God intervened in her life and deeply transformed her.

Agatha is a reminder of what we desire for all the women at Samaritana—that

they are saved and safe, and also on a journey of deep transformation, becoming women of integrity and leadership, and shining as examples to others. Agatha is a witness at home with her family, a leader at Samaritana and the Samaritana women's cooperative, and a hard worker with dreams and hopes. We thank God for Agatha and God's work in her life!
