“ MINISTRY STORY

While training village midwives, we surveyed the birth experiences of a couple of hundred village women. We encountered many tragic stories. In one village, Jeanine was troubled when several women said there was a woman who, after an illness, had been unable to get out of bed. Her muscles were too weak to support her, and her husband had sent her home to her mother. They asked Jeanine, since she could speak Bengali, to go to the young woman's house and pray for her. Unable to do anything as a wife or mother, she was still living in her mother's house. Jeanine prayed.

Six months later, we were back in her village. The woman said excitedly that, after Jeanine prayed for her, she got out of bed and took a few faltering steps. She has been gaining strength slowly, trying to walk more every day. She asked that we pray for her again, so she can return to her husband and children. A dozen women stood with us, this time as Walt prayed to Jesus, the Great Physician. Tears of

gratitude streamed down the woman's face. Her friends asked us to return and see how God continues to answer our prayers.
